Enrollment for the 2008-2009 school year is here.

- **Enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis**
- **Enrollment for Saint Thomas Lutheran members wishing to register their children in Kindergarten begins the week of February 4.**
- **Re-enrollment for students in grades 1-8 will begin February 4.**
- **Re-enrollment for students wishing to return for Kindergarten will begin February 18.**

The Board of Education has passed a "New Registration Policy". During the enrollment period beginning February 2008, individuals with any outstanding balances, tuition, or fees, will not be allowed to enroll during the enrollment period of February and March. A spot will not be held, until all fees are paid and registration takes place.
